Other Tips:

Shop Around. Online travel agencies like Expedia or Travelocity don't include Southwest Airlines, which comprise about 50% of RNO's flights.

Be Flexible. Fridays, Sundays and Mondays are usually higher priced days for airfare. Consider extending your stay or arriving early to take advantage of lower fare days.

Book One-Way. The flexibility of booking different airlines for inbound and outbound flights can often provide lower roundtrip costs.

Consider Extra Fees. Before booking tickets, review the airline policies on extra fees, such as baggage, to determine overall value.

Don't Stop Looking. Government regulations require all airlines to refund tickets within 24 hours of purchase *for any reason*. If the price of a flight drops within 24 hours of purchase, you can get a refund and purchase the lower priced flight. Southwest doesn't charge fees for rebooking flights. If you find a SWA flight at a lower price, just rebook.

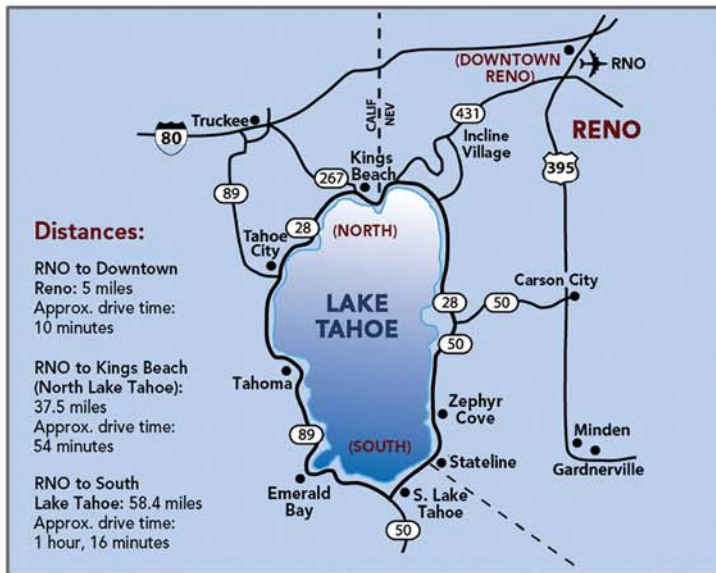

Reno-Tahoe International Airport (RNO) is in the heart of Reno, only 35 miles from Lake Tahoe.



RNO is within 5 miles of most major hotels in town. Getting around the region is easy with a wide array of ground transportation options at RNO.

Rental Cars. RNO provides access to 9 rental car agencies with vehicle pick-up available *right outside the terminal*: Alamo, Avis, Budget, Dollar, Enterprise, Hertz, National, Payless and Thrifty.

Hotel Shuttles. Many hotels provide complimentary shuttle service including: Atlantis, Circus Circus, Eldorado, Grand Sierra Resort, Harrah's Reno, Nugget, Peppermill, Sands and Silver Legacy. For more information: www.RenoAirport.com/to-from-airport/shuttles.

Lake Tahoe Shuttles. Paid shuttle service is available to both North and South Lake Tahoe.
